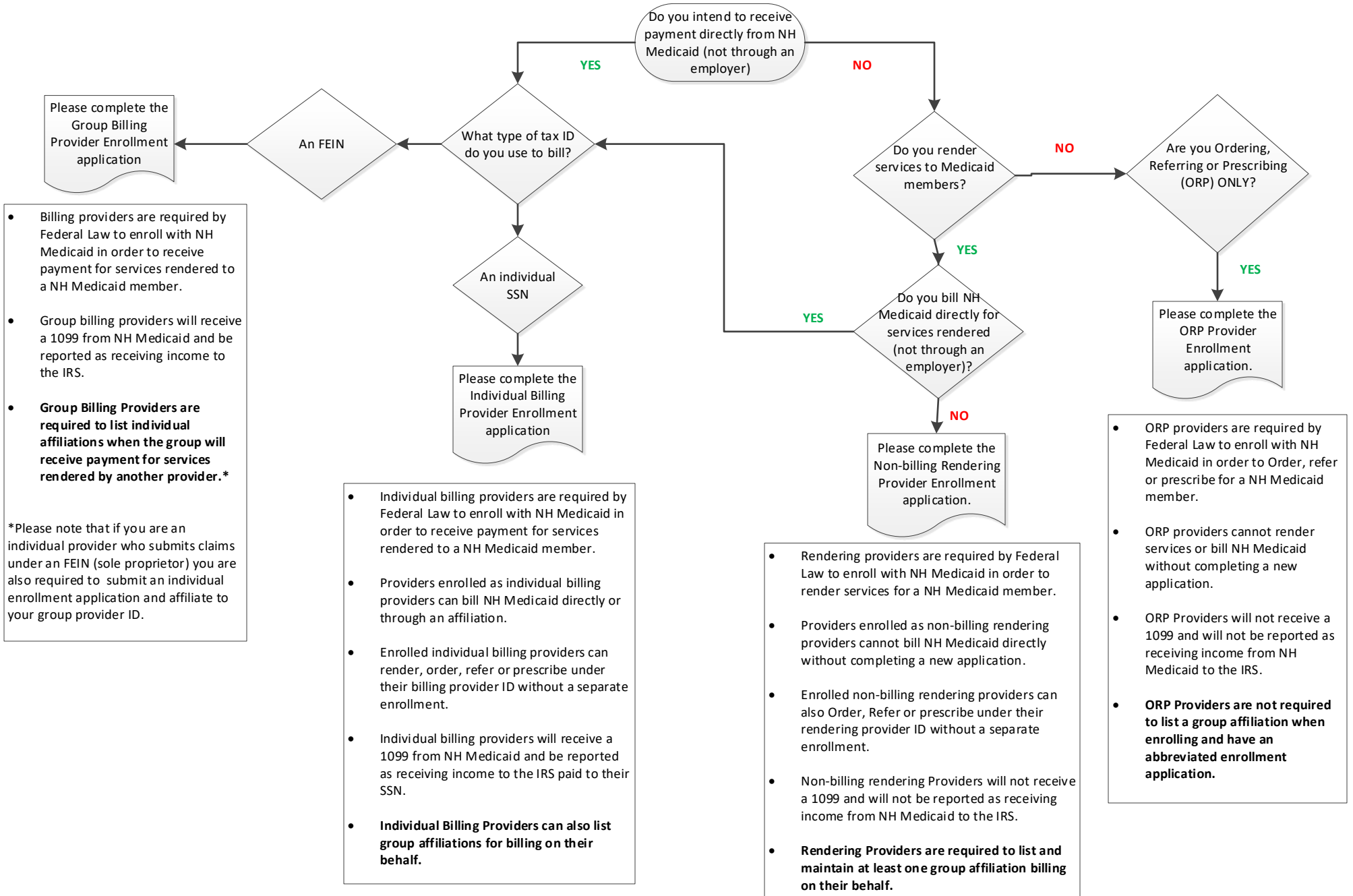




New Hampshire Medicaid Provider Enrollment Application Guidelines

This chart will help newly enrolling providers to identify which type of application they should complete for their NH Medicaid enrollment. For additional assistance in identifying and completing the appropriate application(s), please contact NH Medicaid Provider Relations at 866-291-1674.



- Billing providers are required by Federal Law to enroll with NH Medicaid in order to receive payment for services rendered to a NH Medicaid member.
 - Group billing providers will receive a 1099 from NH Medicaid and be reported as receiving income to the IRS.
 - **Group Billing Providers are required to list individual affiliations when the group will receive payment for services rendered by another provider.***
- *Please note that if you are an individual provider who submits claims under an FEIN (sole proprietor) you are also required to submit an individual enrollment application and affiliate to your group provider ID.

- Individual billing providers are required by Federal Law to enroll with NH Medicaid in order to receive payment for services rendered to a NH Medicaid member.
- Providers enrolled as individual billing providers can bill NH Medicaid directly or through an affiliation.
- Enrolled individual billing providers can render, order, refer or prescribe under their billing provider ID without a separate enrollment.
- Individual billing providers will receive a 1099 from NH Medicaid and be reported as receiving income to the IRS paid to their SSN.
- **Individual Billing Providers can also list group affiliations for billing on their behalf.**

- Rendering providers are required by Federal Law to enroll with NH Medicaid in order to render services for a NH Medicaid member.
- Providers enrolled as non-billing rendering providers cannot bill NH Medicaid directly without completing a new application.
- Enrolled non-billing rendering providers can also Order, Refer or prescribe under their rendering provider ID without a separate enrollment.
- Non-billing rendering Providers will not receive a 1099 and will not be reported as receiving income from NH Medicaid to the IRS.
- **Rendering Providers are required to list and maintain at least one group affiliation billing on their behalf.**

- ORP providers are required by Federal Law to enroll with NH Medicaid in order to Order, refer or prescribe for a NH Medicaid member.
- ORP providers cannot render services or bill NH Medicaid without completing a new application.
- ORP Providers will not receive a 1099 and will not be reported as receiving income from NH Medicaid to the IRS.
- **ORP Providers are not required to list a group affiliation when enrolling and have an abbreviated enrollment application.**
